



COVID Protocols

The following COVID Protocol's are in place for this meet.

- Maximum of 3 Spectators per Competing Gymnast.
- Maximum 2 Coach per 6 competing gymnasts per session
- Masks to be worn at all times by NON-competing gymnasts.
- Social distancing to be observed.
- All Concession booths will be closed. No Food or Drink will be sold.
- We will supply chalk and water bottles. Feel free to bring your own if preferred.
- 12/28/2021 : Any visitors on campus for more than 4 hours, must provide proof of vaccination, negative COVID test, or Proof of Antigen Test.
- 01/10/2022: With regards to at home tests: Coaches/Judges who wish to test out will need to provide dated picture proof of their antigen result. A picture with their phone that is time and date stamped will suffice. The date and time stamp can be found under details in the Gallery.
- 02/07/2022: After a lengthy conversation with management today, we were advised that Athletes/spectators staying for only 1 session do NOT need to show anything, but mask mandating is required. Security will ask you if you are only staying for 1 session, if the answer is YES, then you are all set. 😊

RIT is really trying to work with us, so if we keep to the rules and keep our numbers per session to below 400, then the Venue will NOT require vaccination status or COVID test results for the athletes or persons in the facility less than 4 hours
