USAIGC ON SITE TRAINING:

There will NOT be an onsite training GYM. We will utilize the “4th” session of the day as a training gym in the MAIN Competition arena. We will do this using a sign up process and the training slots will run from 5:00pm to 8:00pm daily on the competition equipment.

Space will be limited. To allow everyone an equal and fair chance to train, we will use an online “SignUp “ system. We have limited the number of slots set to 48 (12 per event) to avoid overcrowding. AGE DETERMINATION:

Age Determination Date for each level is the Date of the Preliminary session.

AGE GROUPS

For each level, we will take the total number of athletes, sort them from youngest to oldest, then create equal age groups. As an example, if we have 100 Gold athletes, we may chose to divide them into 5 equal age groups of about 20 girls. Doing it this way makes for a more balanced awards, and event finals.

COMPETITION FORMAT:

PRELIMINARIES

We will be running the meet as a Modified Capitol Cup format.

We will warmup the first flight of girls, and when they start competing, the second flight will begin their timed warmup. You will compete on the equipment you warm up on.

We will set up the sessions, so we compete by each level **BY AGE DIVISION**. This way, all the kids of the same age compete against each other. This does mean that coaches may have to coach multiple sessions of the same level, but at the end of the day, this meet is your athletes world championship. We will thus be able to announce the event final qualifiers after each preliminary session.

EVENT FINALS

AFTER conclusion of the Final session for that level, the event finalists will be determined, and the event finals will be posted on the website for competition the following day.

Rotation sheets will be made available on the website. We will make EVERY EFFORT to not have the coaches on 2 events at the same time, but please remember, based on numbers, it may not always work out that simple. The details around team finals will be determined at a later date

AWARDS - PRELIMINARY SESSIONS – ALL-AROUND

AFTER each session we will acknowledge and medal the Top **Preliminary All Rounders** for each age group. This will result in multiple Preliminary All-Around champions across the multiple sessions for the level for each age group.

At the conclusion of each session for the preliminaries for the level, we will announce the Top Event Finalists for each age-group. The top 3 All-Arounders for all age groups, across all sessions for that level, will be announced and awards presented at the event Finals session to acknowledge the TRUE world champion.

AWARDS - INDIVIDUAL EVENT FINALS

The top number of gymnasts on each event for each age group making event finals on that event is listed below in the matrix. (across all preliminary sessions for the level). We will medal out 100% for each age group for each event during the Event Finals

We will ALSO medal out the TOP 3 **USAIGC World Champion All-Arounders** for each age division based on the Preliminary sessions (NOT the event finals) . We will thus end up with the following for awards:

- Preliminary All-Around Champions (for each age group for each session – TOP 10)
- USAIGC World Vault/Bars/Beam/Floor Champions (See Matrix Below)
- USAIGC World All Around Champions – Top 3 per Level

AWARDS - INDIVIDUAL EVENT AWARDS

The following places will be honored for the event finals, but this is subject to change based on adds and scratches that may occur. (TBD)

TEAM AWARDS

We will be acknowledging 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams for Small, Medium and Large Teams.

The number of kids making up teams are as follows:

- Small Teams – 3-5 athletes – Count Top 3 Scores
- Medium Teams – 6-8 athletes – Count Top 5 Scores
- Large Teams – 9+ athletes – Count Top 7 Scores

Please NOTE: **ONLY All-Around athletes** are considered when determining the team size for awards purposes. The scores of Individual event specialists will NOT be considered in determining the Team score. The number of kids making up small/medium and large may change to have a better mix and balance of competition. We will Present TEAM WINNERS at the commencement of the EVENT FINALS. This way, most of the kids and parents will be present.
